# The CoP

- ▶ Informal network of professionals and practitioners;
- ▶ Dedicated to sharing their experiences and knowledge;
- ▶ Informed dialogue with decision-makers;
  - ▶ The CoP has stimulated learning, promoted professional development, addressed individual questions, and generated knowledge on cash transfer programs;
  - ▶ Anglophone CoP in the map



# Functions of the CoP SC

---

The Steering Committee members are expected to:

- ▶ Lead the CoP activities, including online meetings, calls, discussions, and other activities;
- ▶ Actively participate the coordination calls with the WB/UNICEF Facilitation Team;
- ▶ Facilitate coordination among the CoP membership;
- ▶ Set VC topics on an annual basis to enable a least four VCs per year;
- ▶ Undertake advocacy and seek opportunities for resource mobilization, through developing plans for future fund-raising activities

# Composition and Duration

---

## The Steering Committee is composed of 6 members

- ▶ These 6 members are elected by the Countries Focal Points and they serve for a period of two (2) years;
- ▶ At the end of the second year:
  - ▶ 3 members will be re-elected for another two years to ensure continuity and transition of institutional memory
  - ▶ 3 new members will be elected for two (2) years

# Criteria for Election:

---

A member of the Steering Committee will be:

- ▶ The Focal Point for the country represented;
- ▶ A government employee (in middle level management, or Senior level in Government CT programs);
- ▶ A member with a good knowledge in the development and implementation of cash transfer programs;
- ▶ An active participant in the CoP, both VCs and Face to Face;
- ▶ A champion who believes in the ideals of the CoP, and can demonstrate it;
